Construction management, in partnership with their employees, is responsible for ensuring that all contractors are held to the same high standards of safety. This includes the use of safety training, safety meetings, and safety programs that are designed to prevent accidents and injuries.



use low bid for selecting contractors. Project owner/client depends on conventional methods of insuring the job (e.g., insurance provided by the contractors).

Project owner/client communicates safety expectations to contractors and consistently enforces them on-site. There is a site-specific safety template for each job that all contractors are required to follow. There are regularly scheduled safety meetings with all contractors and owners. Injury and illness trends are used to determine weaknesses. Safety programs are reviewed at least annually.

Contractors are selected based on safety practices/ climate rather than low bid. Project owner/client participates in daily planning meetings, are regularly on-site to connect with and learn from employees, and
